Take a Walk Through History

Established in 1821, the City Cemetery has been in continuous use housing the who's who of Columbus history. When you walk through the City Cemetery, you are able to see a historic record of Columbus from Clessie Cummins to Joseph I. Irwin. As you walk through the cemetery, you are also able to see a historic record of our country. The City Cemetery houses 250 military graves from the Mexican War, Civil War, Spanish American War, World War I, and World War II. There are 12 unknown soldiers from the Civil War at the City Cemetery. Wounded soldiers were sent from the battlefields to hospitals in the north by train. Those who died on the trip were left at each stop for burial.

Columbus Park Foundation and the Columbus Parks and Recreation is responsible for honoring this history through managing and maintaining the City Cemetery. Park Operations works to keep the grave sites at the City Cemetery mowed and maintained in order show the proper respect to those buried at the cemeteries and the families that entrusted the memory of their loved ones in Parks and Recreation care. Columbus Parks and Recreation works with volunteer groups to recognize the veterans in the Cemetery for Memorial Day and Veterans Day by placing flags on each grave site.

Columbus Pickleball Campaign

The Columbus Pickleball Club (CPC) has worked tirelessly with the Columbus Park Foundation and Parks Department to raise funds for the expansion of Pickleball opportunities in Columbus. Throughout the course of an aggressive fundraising campaign, CPC has focused on expanding the Pickleball courts in Donner Park due to the fact that the popularity of Pickleball has surpassed the needs for the two originally constructed courts in Donner Park. By holding tournaments, clinics, and other fundraisers, CPC successfully raised over \$97,000! Funds from this multi-year fundraiser were used to build four more courts in Donner Park and actively contribute to ensure availability of funds for future maintenance of the courts. The ribbon cutting to commemorate the completion of this campaign and court construction, was held in August. The largest annual fundraiser is the Discover Columbus Pickleball Tournament (DCPT), which is a USA Pickleball Association sanctioned outdoor tournament. DCPT raises on average, \$14,000 annually to contribute to the growth of the Pickleball fund and increase opportunities in Columbus.

Playgrounds Better Our Community


Playgrounds create community. Parents can talk to parents, kids can climb and swing and run with other kids, and neighborhoods can get to know each other.

Freedom Field is one of our playgrounds that creates a community around it. This playground was designed so that children of all abilities can play together, and gives adults with differing abilities the chance to enjoy the playground with their children or other young relatives.

Creating inclusive playgrounds, like Freedom Field, in our community gives all children the opportunity to learn life skills and boost their health by playing on playgrounds. When children are at their community playground, they get to interact with more children than their usual social circle, and create and play games that require cooperating and communicating with new friends. Children are able to carry these skills into adulthood when they are in the workplace and other social settings. Playgrounds provide free opportunities for children to be healthy and active. Climbing and playing on playgrounds build more muscles than most sports while allowing children to work out at their own pace, and because children have so much fun playing, they don't realize that they are exercising.

If we do not have playgrounds like Freedom Field in our community that provide inclusive equipment or surfacing, then children with differing abilities are put at a disadvantage. They are not able to socialize with their peers to learn cooperation and communication or be able to take advantage of the physical benefits of playing on a playground. Studies show that children perceive those who play with them are "contributors", and those that are not able to play with them are not. By preventing children with differing abilities from being able to play on playgrounds, other children see them as not equal. Making sure playground equipment and surfacing is accessible for kids of all abilities is a key way to ensure all children are able to learn skills and achieve critical peer status on equal ground.

We have begun the journey of having inclusive playground equipment and surfacing with Freedom Field. As we reimagined the James A. Henderson Playground, we worked to include elements to have inclusive play opportunities. Now we need to look at the rest of the outdoor playgrounds. We need to update our outdoor playgrounds, and this gives us the chance to make our playgrounds even better for our children now and for future generation.
