Girls Locker Room Project

Hamilton Community Center and Ice Arena needs to expand in order to better serve our community and visitors. Hamilton does not have a dedicated space for girls and women to use, except for the women's restroom, when participating in ice activities. As the Girl's Hockey League, along with figure skating and other ice programs, continue to grow, the participants need a locker room to get ready.

This additional locker room will give HCCIA the opportunity to host more hockey tournaments including women's hockey tournaments and bigger men's tournaments. Bringing in bigger tournaments will increase sports tourism benefitting Columbus's economy through hotel stays, restaurant visits, and more.


